Bruce E. Bursten

Distinguished University Professor Department of Chemistry

ruce E. Bursten, professor of chemistry, was named an Ohio State Distinguished University Professor in October 1997. His teaching, writing, and research have also earned him two of the university's prestigious Alumni Distinguished Teaching Awards in 1982 and 1996 and a Distinguished Scholar Award in 1990.

A nationally recognized theoretical chemist, Professor Bursten is known for his work in the electronic structure of metal complexes and in chemical bonding theory. He is co-author of a general chemistry textbook used throughout the United States and abroad to teach undergraduate students and is author or co-author of more than 100 research papers. In addition, he has presented more than 100 research seminars at other universities.

The Chicago native received his bachelor of science in chemistry with honors from the University of Chicago in 1974 and a Ph.D. in chemistry from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1978. After conducting postdoctoral research as a National Science Foundation Fellow at Texas A&M University, he joined the Ohio State faculty in 1980 as an assistant professor of chemistry, becoming full professor in 1990. He serves as an adjunct professor of chemistry at Kent State University.

His current research activities are supported by research grants from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Department of Energy, Los Alamos National Laboratory, and the Ohio Supercomputer Center.

Professor Bursten has received numerous honors for his academic

accomplishments. In 1984, he received a Camille and Henry Dreyfus Foundation Teacher-Scholar Award, and he was named a fellow of the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation the following year. In addition to his Distinguished Teaching and Scholar Awards, he received the Colleges of Arts and Sciences Student Council Outstanding Teaching Award in 1984 and the Colleges of Arts and Sciences Honors Faculty Service Award in 1995. He is a charter member of Ohio State's Academy of Teaching and an honorary member of the Chimes and Sphinx class honoraries and the Golden Key National Honor Society.

Ohio State warmly welcomes one of its own distinguished scholars to address today's graduates.

Stanley N. Katz

Doctor of Laws

tanley N. Katz is lecturer with the rank of professor, Public and International Affairs, at Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School, and co-director of Princeton's Center for Arts and Cultural Policy Research. From 1986 to 1997, he served as president of the American Council of Learned Societies.

One of America's foremost legal historians, Dr. Katz has had a distinguished academic career, serving on the faculties of several of the nation's most prestigious universities.

The Chicago native received his bachelor's, master's, and doctorate degrees from Harvard University in 1955, 1959, and 1961, respectively. His first academic appointment was as an instructor at Harvard's Department of History. In 1965, he joined the University

of Wisconsin's history faculty, moving in 1971 to the University of Chicago, where he served as professor of legal history, professor of history, and associate dean of the law school—a remarkable achievement for someone without a law degree.

In 1978, he was named Class of 1921 Bicentennial Professor of the History of American Law and Liberty at Princeton University. He was co-appointed Professor of Public and International Affairs in the Woodrow Wilson School in 1982 and held both appointments until 1986 when he was named Senior Fellow in the Wilson School. From 1979 to 1986, he also served as visiting professor of law at the University of Pennsylvania.

As president of the American Council of Learned Societies, Dr. Katz administered one of the most important scholarly institutions in the nation, and he remains an outspoken advocate for the liberal arts and the ideals of intellectual exchange. He has written, co-authored, or edited more than 50 books and scholarly articles and has presented numerous lectures and papers on American history, legal history, and education and the humanities. He co-founded *Reviews in American History*, the leading journal devoted to new literature in American history, and has served as associate editor since 1973.

His many honors include election as a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, fellow of the Society of American Historians, and member of the American Philosophical Society.

Ohio State is honored to present this eminent scholar of humanities, history, and the law with its own recognition.

Gerhard Levy

Doctor of Science

erhard Levy is University
Distinguished Professor of
Pharmaceutics Emeritus (active)
at the State University of New York at
Buffalo School of Pharmacy.

A renowned leader in pharmaceutical education and research, Dr. Levy was instrumental in the founding of the scientific field of biopharmaceutics and has made major contributions to the understanding of how drugs act.

Born in Germany, he received his bachelor of science in pharmacy in 1955 and his doctor of pharmacy in 1958 from the University of California, San Francisco. He joined the faculty of the University of Buffalo (now SUNY/Buffalo) in 1958 as an assistant professor of pharmacy, serving as acting department chair the following year. In 1964,

Dr. Levy was named professor of biopharmaceutics, and he served as chair of SUNY/Buffalo's Department of Pharmaceutics from 1966-70 and as director of the Clinical Pharmacokinetics Research Center from 1979-88. He was given emeritus status in 1995.

Dr. Levy is an elected member of the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences and holds honorary degrees from five universities. The author of more than 500 scientific publications, he was one of the 300 most cited authors in the world scientific literature from 1961 to 1979 and one of the 500 most cited scientists from 1973 to 1984, according to published surveys by the Institute for Scientific Information. He has served on the editorial or advisory boards of numerous scientific journals.

Among his many honors are the 1990 Gold Medal of the Slovak Medical Society, the 1990 Scheele Award of the Swedish Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences, the 1992 Dale E. Wurster Research Award in Pharmaceutics from the American Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists, and the first Lifetime Achievement in the Pharmaceutical Sciences Award of the International Pharmaceutical Federation in 1994.

It is with pride that Ohio State recognizes the many contributions to the field of pharmaceutics by this distinguished scholar and researcher.



Marcel Marceau

Doctor of Humane Letters

arcel Marceau, internationally acclaimed as the world's greatest mime, is celebrating the 50th anniversary of the creation of the beloved character BIP, whose striped pullover and battered top hat are universally familiar.

A native of Strasbourg, France, Mr. Marceau enrolled in Charles Dullin's School of Dramatic Art in Paris in 1946, where he studied under Etienne Decroux. The following year he created BIP, who was to become his dramatic alter ego, and his reputation as a master of pantomime began to grow. In 1949, after winning the renowned Deburau Prize for his second mimodrama, *Death before Dawn*, Mr. Marceau formed his Compagnie de Mime Marcel Marceau—

the only company of pantomime in the world at the time.

Following several successful European tours, Mr. Marceau made his first North American tour in 1955-56, beginning with sold-out appearances in Canada, before arriving in New York where his show was moved to a larger theater to accommodate public demand. During his first U.S. tour, he played to standing room only crowds in San Francisco, Chicago, Washington, Philadelphia, Los Angeles, and other major cities. A veteran of numerous television appearances both here and abroad, Mr. Marceau won a 1956 Emmy for his appearance on an NBC spectacular.

Upon his return to France, a retrospective of his mimodramas ran for a year at Paris' Ambigu Theatre. In 1978, the City of Paris awarded him a grant to open the Ecole de Mimodrame de Paris. The French government has honored him with its highest award, naming him an Officier de la Legion d'Honneur.

Mr. Marceau has continued to tour worldwide through the years, and in 1995 presented a three-day artist-in-residence program at Ohio State's departments of theatre and dance. He is currently on an official 50th anniversary tour of North America.

Ohio State is honored to present its own award to this innovative and legendary artist.

John T. Eby Distinguished Service Award

ohn T. Eby retired in 1995 after a long and productive career with the Ford Motor Company. At the time of his retirement, he was executive director of corporate strategy for Ford in Dearborn, Michigan.

He graduated from Ohio State's then College of Administrative Science (now the Fisher College of Business) in 1962 with bachelor of science degree in Business Administration. His service to the university began during his student days when he was a member and president of Ohio Staters, Inc. and Bucket and Dipper. He served as vice president of Phi Delta Theta and Sphinx and as a senior justice of the Interfraternity Court. He was the recipient of a Sloan Scholarship and a Pace Setters Award as an outstanding business student.

Following graduation, he worked in planning and marketing for the Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company before joining the Ford Motor Company where he held a number of positions, including president of the Ford Motor Company of Japan from 1981-84. As executive director of corporate strategy, he was a leader in implementing the quality improvement policies and practices that helped turn Ford around.

During President E. Gordon Gee's tenure, Mr. Eby was instrumental in establishing the university's Total Quality Business and Education Partnership with Ford, which has served as a catalyst for continuous quality improvements throughout the university.

Long active in alumni affairs,

Mr. Eby served on the Alumni Advisory Council as a regional campus representative and a University College representative from 1979 to 1985. During that time he assisted the university in setting up an agenda for encouraging student applications for international scholarships. He was elected to a five-year term on the Alumni Association's board of directors in 1988, serving as president from 1991-93. In 1987, he was honored at Ohio State's 300th commencement as an outstanding alumnus.

A renewed commitment to quality and service throughout the university is testament to the leadership of this valued alumnus.

J. Gilbert Reese

Distinguished Service Award

Gilbert Reese is senior partner of the law firm Reese, Pyle, Drake & Meyer; president of the Thomas J. Evans Foundation; and chairman of the First Federal Savings and Loan Association.

Mr. Reese holds a 1949 bachelor of arts and a 1952 Juris Doctor degree from Ohio State, and he has retained close ties to his alma mater, especially in his service to the College of Law and the Newark campus. He served as chair of the College of Law National Council from 1972-78, and continues to play an active role in faculty recruiting, fund raising, and other law school related activities. He received the College of Law's Distinguished Alumnus Award in 1979. In recent years, he was actively involved in the successful effort to

remodel and build an addition to the law school.

A strong supporter of education in central Ohio, Mr. Reese was instrumental in establishing Ohio State's Newark campus, helping to select and raise funds for the land on which the school was established. In 1971, he provided leadership in creating the co-located technical college at the regional campus and is a trustee emeritus of the Central Ohio Technical College. He has served as chair of the Newark Campus Development Fund since its 1983 inception, helping to raise funds for the support and development of the campus.

As president of Licking County's Thomas J. Evans Foundation, Mr. Reese has earmarked funds for the development and beautification of the Newark campus as well as the surrounding community. He is chair of the Licking Memorial Health Systems Board and, in 1992, received the board's Lifetime Achievement Award.

He has served as a trustee of the Columbus Museum of Art, trustee and president of the Newark YMCA, trustee of the Columbus College of Art and Design, president of the Licking County Bar Association, president of the Newark Area Chamber of Commerce, trustee and secretary of the Institute of Industrial Technology, trustee of Dawes Arboretum, and chair of the Governing Committee of the Licking County Foundation.



THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities

gradually passed from the church, some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In the light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the

cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: Black, long or short sleeves with a reshaped panel

extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, with honors in the liberal arts, and with honors in pharmacy.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.* **Master:** Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

* Not usually worn by candidates for a degree.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree.

The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:




