Commencement Speaker

Mary L. Good

Mary L. Good is president of Engineered Materials Research for Allied-Signal, Inc., an advanced technology company whose primary businesses are in aerospace/electronics, automotive, and engineered materials. She is also president-elect of the American Chemical Society, the world's largest professional scientific organization devoted to a single discipline. Her professional activities have encompassed both academic and industrial scientific research and have included a continuing role in science policy at the national level.

A Texan by birth, Good grew up and was educated in Arkansas. After receiving a Ph.D. in inorganic chemistry from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville in 1954, she began a career of teaching and research in chemistry and materials science with the Louisiana State University System and the University of New Orleans. Good moved into industry in 1980, becoming vice president and director of research at UOP, a company well known in the industry for its oil and gas processing technology.

Good's activities in science policy include service on the National Science Board and on several National Academy of Science panels and government advisory committees. Her service in other professional organizations includes five years as president of the Inorganic Division of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry.

Good also has been active in the community, contributing service to such organizations as Zonta International, in which she serves as chair of the Amelia Earhart Awards Committee, and as a member of the Chicago Network. She is a member of the board of trustees of the Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York, and of the board of directors of the Industrial Research Institute.

She was elected a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science in 1986 and has received honorary doctoral degrees from the University of Arkansas, the University of Illinois-Chicago, and Clarkson University. The University is proud to welcome this very distinguished member of the scientific world to our campus today.

Recipients of Honors

Frederick J. Doyle Doctor of Science

Frederick J. Doyle is currently the senior advisor for cartography at the National Mapping Division of the U.S. Geological Survey in Reston, Virginia. He plans, directs, and performs research on aircraft and space sensors and ground processing systems for the National Mapping Program. He also is an adjunct professor of photogrammetry at George Washington University and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University. Prior to joining the survey in 1967, Doyle was an assistant professor of photogrammetry and first chairperson of the Department of Geodetic Science at Ohio State.

Born in Oak Park, Illinois, Doyle received his bachelor's degree in civil engineering *summa cum laude* in 1951. He studied at the International Training Centre for Aerial Survey in Delft, Netherlands, on a Fulbright Fellowship and did graduate work in mathematics at Ohio State and in astronomy at Georgetown University.

In recent years, Doyle's primary concerns have been the applications of satellites to reconnaissance and mapping. He was chairperson of the Apollo Orbital Science Photographic Team and received the NASA medal for exceptional scientific achievement for his work in lunar mapping. One of Doyle's most significant accomplishments was his work with the large format camera that was first flown on October 5, 1984, on Space Shuttle Mission STS-41-G, reflecting 20 years of research. Over 2,000 pictures were received by the world's mapping community, marking the first time that space photography suitable for maps was obtained for civilian purposes.

His scientific and leadership qualities have been recognized nationally and internationally by his election as president and honorary life member of the American Society of Photogrammetry and his service as secretary general and president of the International Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing.

Doyle has received Meritorious and Distinguished Service Awards from the Department of the Interior, and an honorary Doctor of Engineering degree from the Technical University of Hannover, Federal Republic of Germany. The Ohio State University is delighted to recognize this very distinguished scientist, teacher, researcher, administrator, and former faculty member.

Arthur E. Adams Distinguished Service Award

Since 1970, when he joined Ohio State as the second dean of the College of Humanities, Arthur E. Adams has epitomized the outstanding service that helps to make Ohio State the institution it is today. Coming to Ohio State from Michigan State, Adams brought with him the ideals of liberal education, serious scholarship, and the notion of responsible faculty governance.

Under Adam's seven-year leadership, the College of Humanities nurtured and expanded departments in a time of difficult growth and change. Under his leadership, the Department of Black Studies and the Center for Comparative Studies were established. During his time, Adams was also a professor in the Department of History and continued to work on his own scholarly activities outside the University. These activities included membership on the Accreditation Commission of the American Council on Higher Education, the Board for Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty, and the Midwestern Universities Consortium for International Activities.

Adams helped bring the University Senate, the governing body of the Ohio State faculty, into being during the early 1970s. Adams also contributed substantially to the development of the Office of Continuing Education, serving as vice provost from 1978-82 and expanding opportunities for education to non-traditional students. From 1982-84 he served as a special assistant to the president and the vice president for research and graduate studies, working toward the development of The Ohio State University Research Park. Adams retired from the University as professor emeritus of history in 1984.

Adams has served on many councils and committees within the University, and has published several books and numerous articles. He has traveled extensively in Europe and the USSR, attending many conferences with government and academic participants. Ohio State is grateful for his many years of dedication to academia and is pleased to extend this honor to him.

Recipients of Honors

Paul G. Craig Distinguished Service Award

Paul G. Craig is professor emeritus of public administration and economics at Ohio State. He served as a faculty member from 1951-70 and from 1972 until his retirement in 1980. Since then he has worked as a consultant in economic forecasting, regional economic analysis and financial analysis for banks, insurance companies, and government.

A native of Middletown, Craig received his bachelor's degree from Otterbein College and his master's and Ph.D. degrees in economics from Ohio State. He served as chairperson of the Department of Economics, as the first dean of the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences, and as the chairperson of the Coordinating Council of Deans for the Colleges of the Arts and Sciences.

Craig was a Ford Foundation Post-Doctoral Fellow in the Institute of Basic Mathematics for Application to Business at Harvard University. He is a member of Beta Gamma Sigma and Phi Beta Kappa. During his career at Ohio State, Craig developed the managerial economics course in the Executive Development Program. He also served on the Faculty Council and was president of the Faculty Club.

He has several civic and professional activities to his credit, including chairperson of the Advisory Committee for Economic Development for the Columbus Area Chamber of Commerce; member of the Ohio Citizens Council for Health and Welfare; member of the Universities Committee of the National Bureau of Economic Research; and trustee of Otterbein College. Craig's long years of service to the fields of economics, public administration, and higher education for business, and to Ohio State uniquely qualify him for this award.

Weldon A. Kefauver Distinguished Service Award

For twenty-six years Weldon A. Kefauver served Ohio State and the publishing world with special distinction as director of The Ohio State University Press. Under his leadership, the University Press has become one of the most well-respected academic presses in the country. Now director emeritus, Kefauver developed a series of publications in the humanities, social sciences, legal studies, and education.

Kefauver is responsible for the University Press' publication of Helen Hooven Santmyer's bestselling book . . . *And Ladies of the Club*,—a book which sold more copies than any other book originally published by a university press. He is well known for his ability to work with authors and editorial boards, for his high standards of excellence, and for nurturing young authors in the development of their work.

Kefauver has been recognized many times by his publishing peers. He has served on the board of directors and as president of the American Association of University Presses and has attended the Asian Conference on Publishing. He has often contributed to *Editor, Author, and Publisher* and has edited *Scholars and Their Publishers*.

He is the recipient of the Association of American University Presses Golden Fluke Award, the Association's Medal in 1984, the Johns Hopkins University Press Centennial Medal, a Citation from the Ohioana Library Association, and The Ohio State University Centennial Service Award.

Kefauver is an alumnus of The Ohio State University, a member of the Society of Scholarly Publishing, the Nathaniel Hawthorne Society, and the Association of American University Professors. He has instituted a great tradition of excellence for The Ohio State University Press. In recognition of his many years of outstanding dedication, Ohio State is pleased to present him with the Distinguished Service Award.



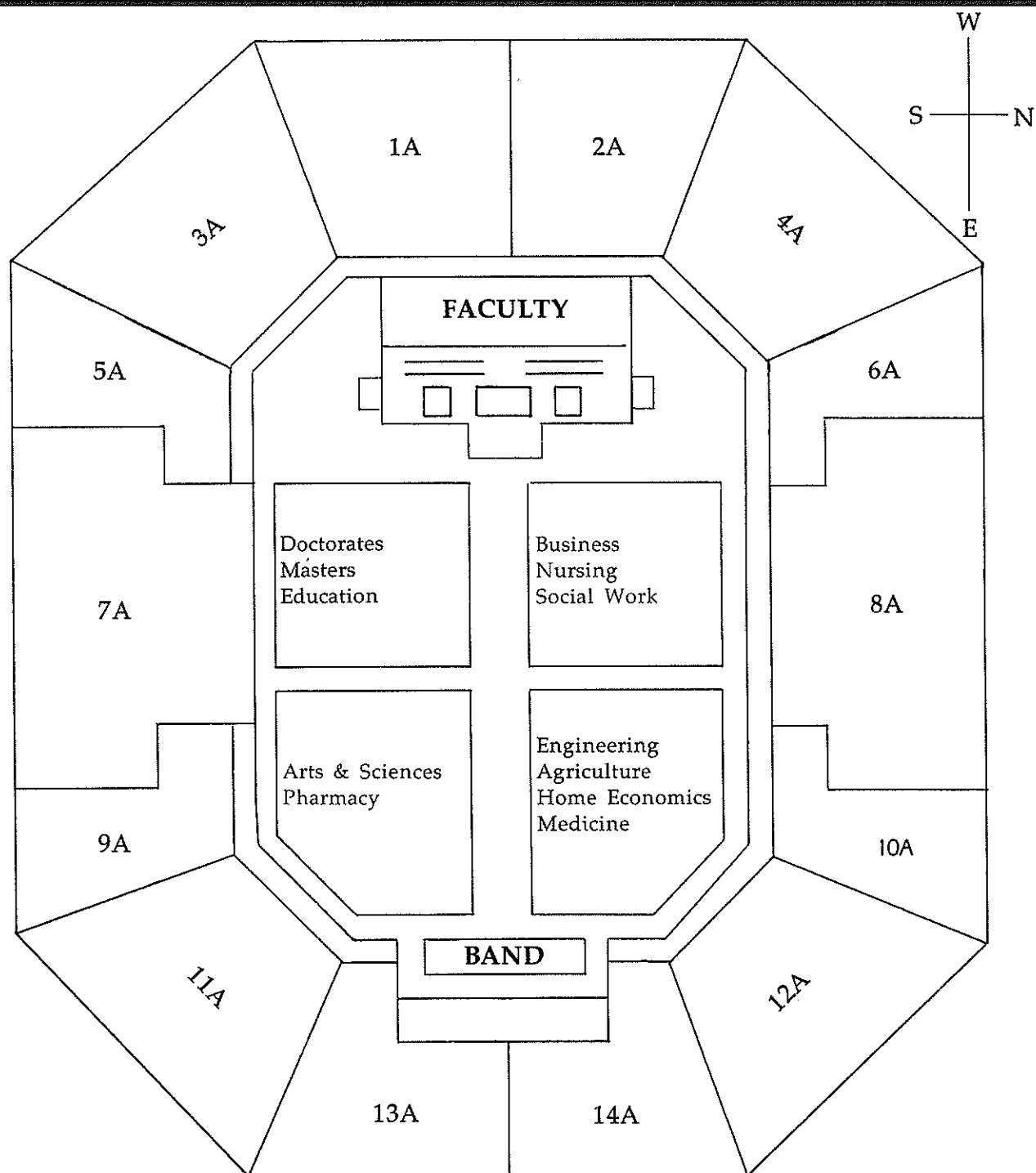

The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor. Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master. Black, long or short sleeves with a re-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor. Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor. Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master. Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Doctor. Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:
