

# Pomp, Circumstance, and Other Songs of a Lifetime

 —by David Citino, Professor of English and Creative Writing and University Poet Laureate (Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head, not to mention a funny robe, full of music—poems and melodies, the tunes we move to, shower and shave by, study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time. Our histories are measures of song. Listen to your heart: drums of Africa, sea-spune of blind, far-sighted Homer, Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying a thousand words. Like Rodolpho in Puccini's La Boheme, Sono un poeta. I am a poet. Che cosa faccio? What do I do? Scrivo. I write. This ceremony

is ioud music—pomp and circumstance of the life you began freshman year or that first day of graduate school. In my head I press *Play*, and the CD of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words. I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery. Up above the world so high, like a diamond in the sky. We knew from the start our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents of Cleveland. Gaudeannss igitur, Juvenes dum sunns. So, let us rejoice, while we are young. Youth is that gift we can't comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were. Don't let the heavy knowledge gained from your studies deprive you of the gifts of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades. Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called King (King of what, fried butter sandwiches?) who stole away her hound dog. You ain't never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend

of mine. As with those profs and TAs, course after course, you had to produce—kill some rabbits—to earn respect. And at times OSU may have seemed like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford, "Sixteen Tons": St. Peter don't you call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe my soul to the company store. You have been digging deep in mines of knowledge. We all owe our souls to Ohio State, company store of learning, shared experience—precious ore we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's fervent urging to wish, sing, fly, Volare, Wo-oo. Cantare, Wo-o-o-o. My grandfather was a peasant farmer, a contadino in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot to dream of flying. Lucky, lucky, lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun. I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours, That leaves eight hours for fun.

Hey! He sailed in steerage across the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where he stayed long enough to work 52 years for the B&O Railroad, before lying down to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere, or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy, Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even, President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage it took to pick up stakes and begin again in a new world! Think of the work those older ones did. For you. You all are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport. You're bound for emigration to the next song of your life. Ohio State is the ark on which you've been sailing. You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, I can see clearly now the rain is gone. The ark, our university, was filled to overflowing with the diversity of us. Diversity. Networks and talk shows devalue the word.

I say, rather, the richness of us, precious difference, the grand multiplicity of selves that balance this globe and enable it to spin true. Grandson of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate in English literature from Ohio State because my family labored long nights around the kitchen table trying to learn this arduous English. I sat where you're sitting twenty-six years ago. Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles! My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history. Now you, graduates, are being honored—

by degrees. We've all come together around the kitchen table of Ohio State. Ohio, Round on the ends and high in the middle. For the years to come we'll sing together, Beautiful Ohio,

in dreams again I see, Visions of what used to be. These psalms, sacred thoughts of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes, CD's—they take up space in shelves of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the runof-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing with pleasure or bathed in the blues. We ache for something grander than pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared are music of the spheres, ways of saying to another something from the soul. Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry is there. Drive, drive on down the field,

Men (and women!) of the Scarlet and Gray. Well, you drove on down the field, and you drove up and down the streets, around and around crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library for a decent place to study. My wife, Mary's, father marched in the first "Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother I lost last year, the one who gave me the stars. Today's music makes us think of the debts we owe, and never can repay. So many of us would not be here

were it not for the lullabyes and songs of dear parents, their parents, theirs. Some are here today in the flesh. Many are not: We mourn them with cadences, of our hearts, Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice, taught us the right words. We must cherish them by remembering every song. When we sing to others, we honor our fathers and mothers, thank them for this day of profound scarlet and gray pomp and circumstance. O, come let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs to Alma Mater raise. Alma mater. Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing mother.

We came of age here, with her help. Well, Mother, we love you, but, like, it's time we moved out, got a place of our own. You're standing there, Mom, gray hair, eyes scarlet

from crying. We won't forget you. Now, even though this ceremony means we're being weaned, taken off the nipple, let's take care to cherish her all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us, and pass them on. We'll remember always, Graduation Day. Summer's heat, and winter's cold, The seasons pass, the years will roll, Time and change

will surely show How firm thy friendship, O-hi-O. We call that little number Carmen Ohio. Carmen means song in Latin. You've worked hard; she is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with the notes, the poems we've written together. You know the score. Continue to work hard for yourselves, and one another. Find the ones who need

you to sing to, for them, in the world. Graduates, this joyful litany, this hymn our ancestors collaborated on with us, the calling of your name today is music to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended on it. It does, you know. It has been an honor for me to speak—and sing to you today. Thank you, graduates, and, again, Congratulations.



## Carl E. Kohrt

arl F. Kohrt is president and CEO of Battelle, one of the premier technology development and commercialization companies in the world. Headquartered in Columbus, Battelle's science and technology reach includes overseeing 16,000 staff members and \$2.7 billion in annual research and development at more than 100 locations. Among its successes are the development of the Xerox machine, pioneering work on the compact disc, and medical technology breakthroughs.

A native of central Illinois, Dr. Kohrt joined Battelle in October 2001, after a distinguished 29-year career at Kodak. His work at Kodak was almost equally divided among research and development, global technical management, and international business. Before his retirement from Kodak as executive

vice president, assistant chief operating officer, and chief technical officer, Dr. Kohrt and his wife, Lynne, lived in Hong Kong, where he led the first-ever acquisition of multiple Chinese stateowned enterprises by a foreign multinational corporation. China is now the second largest market for Kodak products.

Dr. Kohrt earned a B.S. in chemistry from Furman University, a master's degree in management science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and a Ph.D. in physical chemistry from the University of Chicago. A distinguished scientist and businessman, he served as a National Science Foundation graduate and post-doctoral fellow at the James Franck Institute, a Woodrow Wilson Fellow (honorary), and a Sloan Fellow.

Dr. Kohrt serves on numerous business and civic organizations, including the board of directors of Scram Technologies; Pharos; Battelle for Kids; Project GRAD-Columbus; COSI Columbus; Brookhaven Science Associates; UT-Battelle; Furman University board of trustees; Ohio Business Roundtable; and the Greater Columbus Chamber of Commerce.

Dr. Kohrt continues to volunteer his time and expertise to The Ohio State University. He has acted as a judge in the Fisher College of Business annual M.B.A. competition, and he serves on the Strategic Development Committee of the College of Medicine and Public Health and on the Fisher College of Business Advisory Board. In addition, he sits on the 17-member committee searching for a new Ohio State vice president for research.

## William F. Ganong

Doctor of Science

Lange Professor of Physiology Emeritus at the University of California, San Francisco. During a long and distinguished career as researcher and educator, Dr. Ganong has conducted an extraordinary number of important studies in endocrinology and neuroendocrinology. His book, Review of Medical Physiology, now in its 21st edition, is considered an essential reference for medical students throughout the world.

A native of Massachusetts, Dr. Ganong received his A.B. cum laude from Harvard University in 1946 and his M.D. magna cum laude from Harvard Medical School in 1949. He served in the U.S. Army in World War II and the Korean War, receiving a combat zone promotion to captain in Korea, where he was one of six medical officers who set up the Hemorrhagic Fever Center.

After completing a research fellowship in medicine and surgery and serving as director of the Surgical Research Laboratory at Harvard, Dr. Ganong began his academic career in the Department of Physiology at the University of California, Berkeley, in 1955. He moved to the university's San Francisco campus in 1958, where he remained until his 1991 retirement. He served as chair of the Department of Physiology from 1970 to 1987 and was named the Jack D. and DeLoris Lange Professor in 1982.

Dr. Ganong's scientific work has concentrated on the mechanisms by which the brain controls several different hormones, particularly those regulating body fluids and nutrients, reproduction, blood pressure, and responses to stress. Since publishing his first research paper in 1952 in the New England Journal of Medicine, he has added more than 500 publications on renin, hypertension, and neuroendocrine physiology.

During his many years of professional service, he has served as president of the American Physiological Society and the Association of Chairs of Departments of Physiology; as vice president of the International Society of Neuroendocrinology; as treasurer of the Society for Neuroscience; and, currently, as second vice president and treasurer of the board of trustees of the French Foundation for Medical Research and Education and secretary of the Emeritus Faculty Association at UC, San Francisco. Dr. Ganong is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Sciences, and he has been a member of a number of editorial boards, including Endocrinology, the American Journal of Physiology and Journal of Applied Physiology, the Journal of Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics, Neuroscience, and the Italian Journal of Physiological Science. He served as editor-in-chief of Neuroendocrinology from 1979 to 1984.

## Dennis J. Greenland

Doctor of Science

n internationally renowned soil scientist, Dennis J. Greenland is currently Honorary Visiting Professor at the University of Reading in England, where he served in the early 1970s as professor and head of the Department of Soil Science.

The scope of Professor Greenland's research and contributions to the field of soil science extends over nearly a half-century and four continents. After earning his master's and Ph.D. degrees at the University of Oxford in 1954, he served as lecturer at the University of Ghana in West Africa, where he began studying the effects of cultivation on soil dynamics. His research led to the 1960 publication of The Soil Under Shifting Cultivation, considered a classic in the field. Then, as a reader in soil science at the University of Adelaide, he worked in southern Australia identifying strategies for sustainable management of soil and water resources,

especially in tropical climates. His research over the years has encompassed a wide range of topics, including the Green Revolution, rice production, efficient fertilizer use, soil structural stability, soil conditioners, soil organic matter effects, and degradation of tropical soils.

In 1974, he was named director of research at the International Institute of Tropical Agriculture in Nigeria. His service as a sought-after scientific administrator continued when he was named deputy director general of the prestigious International Rice Research Institute in Los Banos, Philippines. In 1987, he was named director of scientific services at the Commonwealth Agricultural Bureau (CAB) International in England. He rejoined the University of Reading faculty in 1988.

Professor Greenland has contributed more than 180 papers to scientific journals and written three books, including Cherish the Earth (1994) and The Sustainability of Rice Farming (1997). In addition, he has edited seven more volumes on soil management. He has long served as a consultant to commercial, government, and United Nations agencies on tropical agricultural development and sustainability of farming practices.

He is currently a member of the Committee on International Programs and the Committee on Statutes and Structures of the International Society of Soil Science. He is a past president of the British Society of Soil Science and a past chair of the Scientific Advisory Panel of the Commonwealth Development Corporation, U.K. His many honors include fellowship in the Royal Society of London, U.K., the World Academy of Arts and Science, and the Institute of Biology, U.K.

## Kenneth L. Coleman

Distinguished Service Award

enneth L. Coleman is a founder, chair, and CEO of ITM Software, an early-stage enterprise software company based in California and focusing on information technology in business. He retired in January 2002 as executive vice president of global sales, service, and marketing for Silicon Graphics, Inc., (SGI), a \$2.3 billion computer systems company, where he had been employed for 15 years. Prior to SGI, he held management positions at Activision and Hewlett-Packard.

Mr. Coleman's ties with Silicon Valley and the information technology industry have been invaluable to The Ohio State University for more than two decades. A longtime member of the Fisher College of Business Dean's Advisory Council, he, along with members of his SGI technical staff,

helped design the college's computer/ communications network, which has received national recognition for its configuration and capabilities. Mr. Coleman also worked with the College of the Arts to provide equipment, technology, and advice to students in the Advanced Computing Center of the Arts and Design.

An active alumnus since receiving his B.S. in business administration in 1965 and his M.B.A. in 1972 from Ohio State, he is a member of the Alumni Association Advisory Council, serving his second three-year term. As co-chair of the National Major Gift Committee in Northern California, he provided a number of opportunities for university leaders to meet with West Coast alumni, donors, and friends to gain support for new and ongoing programs.

He also served as chair of Ohio State's 2000-01 Annual Fund. He has served as a mentor for numerous Ohio State students, helping them with career opportunities in information technology, and actively recruiting West Coast students to the university. He has worked with university administrators to help improve the campus climate for African American students.

Mr. Coleman is the recipient of numerous honors, including the Fisher College of Business Distinguished Alumni Award, the National Alliance of Black School Educators Living Legend Award, the American Leadership Forum of Silicon Valley Exemplary Leader Award, the One Hundred Black Men of Silicon Valley Lifetime Achievement Award, and instatement into the Silicon Valley Junior Achievement Business Hall of Fame.

## Ralph A. Rockow

Distinguished Service Award

alph A. Rockow is founder and president of Exodyne, Inc., of Phoenix, where he oversees the operations of three wholly owned subsidiaries offering engineering and technical support services, training and educational services, and manufacturing and facilities management. His companies have more than 1,350 employees.

He received his B.S. and M.S. degrees in mechanical engineering from The Ohio State University and holds an Advanced Management College Certificate from Stanford University. Mr. Rockow has maintained close ties with his alma mater over the years through his volunteer efforts on behalf of the College of Engineering. He was instrumental in the formation of the Mechanical Engineering Alumni Society and is the recipient of the 1979 Distinguished Alumnus Award and the 1998

Benjamin G. Lamme Meritorious Achievement Medal—its highest award—from the College of Engineering.

Mr. Rockow has served as chair of the College of Engineering Industrial Advisory Committee and has been a member of the college's Steering Committee and Committee for Tomorrow. He also served two terms as the Alumni Association Advisory Council's representative to the university's Office of Research. In 2001, he was elected to The Ohio State University Foundation Board of Directors. Mr. Rockow and his wife, Barbara, spearheaded a drive for alumni gifts to establish the Arizona Room in the Longaberger Alumni House, as well as establishing the Alumni House's Rockow Board Room. He has actively supported the college's Formula Lightning Electric Car Race Program and has endowed a scholarship honoring his former mechanical engineering professor, Marion Smith.

Prior to his current position, Mr. Rockow held a number of positions at Talley Industries from 1976 to 1982, including president of the government and technical products group. His previous positions include leadership roles at Dynamic Service, Inc., where he guided the company as it took a major role in advancing the state-of-the-art safety in automobiles, and as manager for Space Technology Laboratories at TRW, where he performed theoretical heat transfer analyses on the Titan, Atlas, and Minuteman Intercontinental Ballistic Missile Programs. Mr. Rockow has written numerous technical papers, has participated in oral paper presentations, and has led panel discussions for key national technical societies. He is a member of numerous trade and community support organizations.



To you, your family, friends, and all those who helped you reach this day go our best wishes. You are joining a great family of Ohio State alumni working together to make a difference around the world.



he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard

square---a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

#### The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Ohio State University Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

#### **Honors Emblem**

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, with honors in business, with honors in the liberal arts, and with honors in pharmacy.

#### The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.\* Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

**Doctor:** Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:

Purple
Green
Pink
Seafoam Green
Olive Green


### Cap and Tassel
