

Orton Hall

Designed in the Richardsonian Romanesque style, Orton Hall opened in 1893 to house the Department of Geology and the Geological Museum and Library. The building was named for Edward Orton, distinguished geologist and first president of the University. The plan of construction, which was conceived by Orton, involved 40 different kinds of stone representing the geology of the state of Ohio. The stones are used in the building in their naturally occurring geologic order. Even the building's carved gargoyles represent the heads of extinct animal life of past geological periods.

In the very early years of this century, Orton Hall was the home of the University Library, the Women's Union, and the office of the Dean of Women and once contained a target range for World War I aviators. Presently undergoing renovation, this campus landmark houses the Department of Geology and Mineralogy, while the building's bell tower contains the beloved Campus Chimes.

The chimes, a set of 12 bells weighing a total of 25,000 pounds, were the gifts of eight University classes, beginning with the class of 1906. Today, twice daily from October to May, student chimers play brief concerts on the chimes, always concluding with "Carmen Ohio," the alma mater of The Ohio State University.

Commencement Speaker

Barbara Uehling became chancellor and professor of psychology at the University of Missouri-Columbia in 1978. In this capacity, she leads the largest campus of a four-campus system.

A graduate of Wichita State University who holds M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in experimental psychology from Northwestern University, Dr. Uehling came to Missouri from the University of Oklahoma, where she had served as provost since 1976. Prior to her tenure at Oklahoma, Dr. Uehling held positions as dean of arts and science at Illinois State University, academic dean of Roger Williams College in Rhode Island, and faculty member at Oglethorpe and Emory Universities in Georgia.

Dr. Uehling is past president and a member of the board of directors of the American Association for Higher Education. Recently she was chosen as one of six elected members of the board of directors for the American Council on Education. In 1978, *Change* magazine, a publication of the Council on Learning, acknowledged Dr. Uehling's leadership in education by naming her one of the "100 Young Leaders of the Academy."





The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square — a shape which ballad folklore suggests resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet.*

Master Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet.*

Doctor Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:
