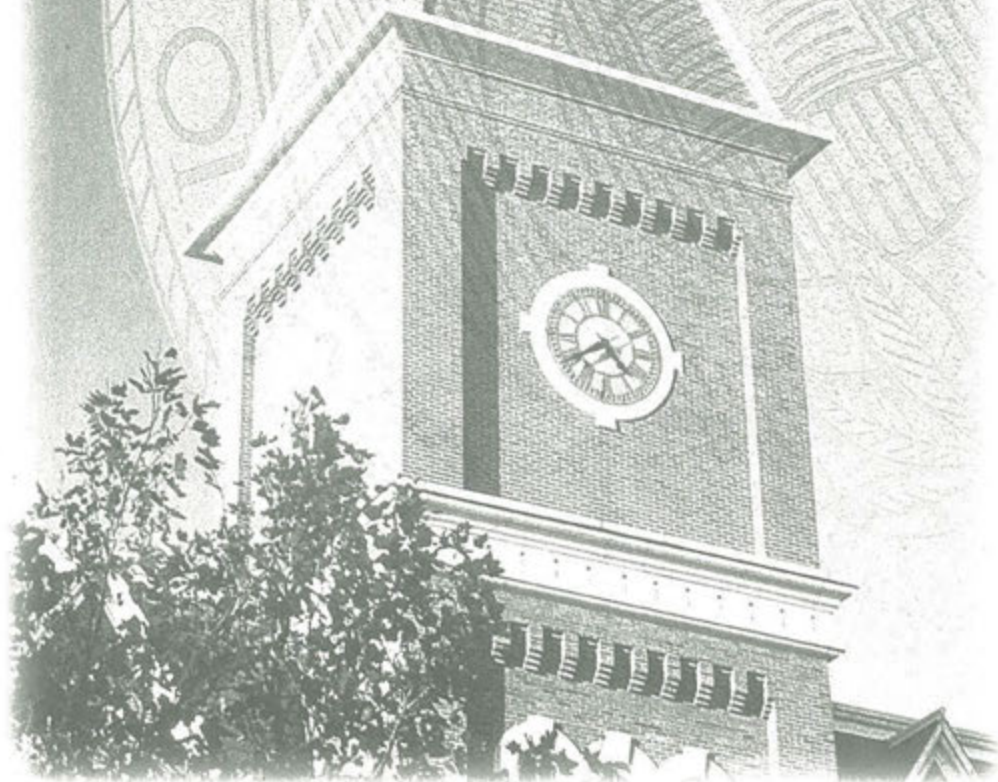

David Citino

David Citino is professor of English and creative writing at Ohio State. A native of Cleveland, he received his undergraduate degree from Ohio University and his master's and doctorate from Ohio State. He taught at the university's Marion campus for 11 years before coming to Columbus in 1985.

Professor Citino is the author of 10 books of poetry, including the *Book of Appassionata: Collected Poems*, published by The Ohio State University Press in 1998. His book *Broken Symmetry* was named a Notable Book of 1997 by the National Book Critics Circle. Other works include *The Weight of the Heart*, *The Gift of Fire*, and *The Appassionata Doctrines*, and he is working on a book of prose, entitled *The Eye of the Poet*.

His work has appeared in countless journals and anthologies.

Among his many honors and awards are a poetry fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts, the first annual poetry award from the Ohioana Library Association, a major fellowship from the Ohio Arts Council, the Dasher Award from the College English Association of Ohio, the Exemplary Faculty Award from Ohio State's College of Humanities, and Ohio State's Alumni Distinguished Teaching Award. He has given readings and lectures and has directed workshops at colleges, libraries, and community centers throughout the nation.

From 1986 to 1993 he served as director of creative writing at Ohio State and was responsible for designing and

securing university and Board of Regents approval of the university's master of fine arts in creative writing degree.

He currently serves as a member of the board of trustees of the Greater Columbus Arts Council; as poetry editor and member of the editorial board of The Ohio State University Press; as facilitator of the literature panel of the Ohio Arts Council; and as a member and past president of the board of trustees of Thurber House, the writers' center located in the restored boyhood home of James Thurber in downtown Columbus.

Ohio State proudly welcomes its own distinguished alumnus and dedicated faculty member to address today's graduating class.

RECIPIENTS OF HONORS

Robert D. Putnam

Doctor of Political Science

Robert D. Putnam is Clarence Dillon Professor of International Affairs in the government department and director of the Center for International Affairs at Harvard University. He is former dean of Harvard's Kennedy School of Government and a former member of the U.S. National Security Council.

The New York native grew up in northern Ohio and received a bachelor of arts degree with highest honors from Swarthmore College in 1963. He earned his master's and doctorate from Yale University in 1965 and 1970. Following graduation, he joined the University of Michigan faculty, and, in 1979, he moved to Harvard as a professor of government, serving as chair of the department from 1984 to 1988. In 1989, he was appointed dean of the Kennedy School of Government and Don K. Price Professor of Politics. He assumed his current academic posts in 1993.

Throughout his career, Professor Putnam has distinguished himself as an academic leader and scholar in the study of foreign policy, political culture, and historical analysis of governments and democracy. He is the author of eight books and numerous book chapters and journal articles. His groundbreaking 1973 book, *The Beliefs of Politicians: Ideology, Conflict, and Democracy in Britain and Italy*, established him as a major figure in his discipline. *Making Democracy Work* (1993) is considered a classic contribution to the study of the roots of democracy in civil society. His most recent work on the decline of social capital in the United States, first published in a famous article entitled "Bowling Alone" in the *Journal of Democracy*, has captured attention from the White House to scholarly meetings in several different disciplines.

In addition to having made a powerful imprint on his field and his university, Professor Putnam has made notable contributions on a national level. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and has served as a fellow at the Wilson Center and the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences. He is a member of the Trilateral Commission, the Council on Foreign Relations, and the International Institute of Strategic Studies. He served as a staff member on the U.S. National Security Council and as a consultant to the Department of State, the Central Intelligence Agency, and The World Bank. He is the recipient of the American Political Science Association's prestigious Ithiel de Sola Pool Award and Lectureship.

Ohio State is privileged to add its own honor to those received by this eminent academician, author, and scholar.

Sir Brian Urquhart

Doctor of International Policy

Sir Brian Urquhart served as one of the United Nations' chief diplomats for four decades before becoming a scholar-in-residence in the Ford Foundation's international affairs program from 1986 to 1995.

A native of Dorset, England, Sir Brian was educated at London's Westminster School and Christ Church, Oxford University. He served in the British Army in infantry and airborne units in North Africa, Sicily, and Europe from 1939 to 1945. Following the war, he became personal assistant to Gladwyn Jebb, executive secretary of the Preparatory Commission of the United Nations in London. In 1946, when the newly formed United Nations moved to its New York headquarters, he was appointed assistant to Trygve Lie, the U.N.'s first secretary general. His behind-the-scenes involvement in crises in Cyprus, the Middle East, and Korea led to his assignment to the office

of the under-secretary general for special political affairs, headed by Ralph Bunche, where he served from 1954 to 1971. As a key member of Bunche's staff, he played a leading role in the development and deployment of the U.N.'s Emergency Force, a ten-nation military force.

He was executive secretary of the first and second U.N. international conferences on the peaceful uses of atomic energy in 1955 and 1958. In 1957, he was the deputy executive director of the preparatory commission of the International Atomic Energy Agency. In 1961, while serving on a peacekeeping mission in the Congo, he was kidnapped and beaten by Katanganese rebels. On his return from the Congo, he resumed his supervisory duties in the special political affairs office, overseeing peacekeeping operations in Cyprus, Jammu and Kashmir, and the Middle East. In 1974, he was appointed under-secretary

general for special political affairs and charged with the direction of peacekeeping forces in the Middle East and Cyprus, as well as negotiations relating to Namibia. He retired from the United Nations Secretariat in February 1986.

Also in 1986, he was knighted by the queen, becoming a Knight Commander of the Order of St. Michael and St. George. He is the recipient of the Franklin D. Roosevelt Freedom from Fear Medal and the International Peace Academy's Distinguished Peacekeeper Award. A noted scholar as well as diplomat, he is the author of biographies on Dag Hammarskjöld and Ralph Bunche; his own memoirs, entitled *A Life in Peace and War*; and *Decolonization and World Peace*. He is a co-author of several books about the United Nations.

It is with great pride that Ohio State recognizes the many contributions to world peace made by this eminent diplomat, activist, and scholar.

RECIPIENTS OF HONORS

Ed Johnson

Distinguished Service Award

A longtime ambassador for agriculture in Ohio, Ed Johnson is president and farm director of ABN in Columbus, which includes ABN Radio, ABN TV, and ABN Publications.

Mr. Johnson received a bachelor of science degree in 1959 from Ohio State's College of Agriculture (now Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences), where he majored in agricultural economics and agricultural education. Following graduation, he taught vocational agriculture for a year, and he continues to guest lecture at Ohio State on a variety of subjects, including communications, education, and veterinary medicine.

In 1974, Mr. Johnson founded the ABN Radio Network, which today serves 75 affiliates in Ohio, Indiana, and West Virginia. He does as many as 130 remote broadcasts each year from

events such as Future Farmers of America (FFA) and 4-H conventions, state and county fairs, camps, farm shows, and festivals. In addition to his radio broadcasts, he produces "Agri Country," a weekly syndicated television program seen on 10 Ohio and Indiana stations, and *Ohio's Country Journal*, a monthly farm magazine with a circulation of 16,000.

His service to the university is extensive. He has served as a member of the College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences Vice President's Advisory Council and Academic Affairs Advisory Council, the Presidents Club Advisory Committee, the Alumni Association Board of Directors, and the Ohio State Extension Development Committee. He has established the G. Edwin Johnson Scholarship Endowment

Fund and is a sponsor of the annual 4-H awards.

He is the recipient of numerous state and national awards and citations for his commitment to agriculture, including the Ohio Agricultural Hall of Fame, Ohio Agri-Women Communicator of the Year, Ohio 4-H Hall of Fame, Ohio Farm Bureau's Distinguished Communicator Award, Columbus Chamber of Commerce Top 10 Small Businessmen in Columbus, Ohio State Fair Hall of Fame, and Ohio FFA VIP Award. He has received awards of recognition from Ohio's Purebred Dairy Cattle Association, Corn Growers, Cattlemen, and Poultry, Pork, and Sheep Associations.

Ohio State proudly recognizes the contributions by this committed alumnus to the university and to Ohio's vital agricultural community.

Isabel Miller

Distinguished Service Award

Isabel Miller is associate professor emeritus on the faculty of early and middle childhood education in Ohio State's College of Education. Although she retired more than 20 years ago, she remains actively involved in her discipline, her college, and her university.

Professor Miller joined the faculty in 1950 after receiving her bachelor of science in education in 1941 and her master's degree in education in 1948, both from Ohio State. During her tenure on the College of Education faculty, she taught undergraduate and graduate courses in early childhood education and children's literature and directed a field-based program in early childhood education. From 1971 to 1979, she served as associate department chair.

She also played an integral role in the initiation of Ohio State's Head Start program.

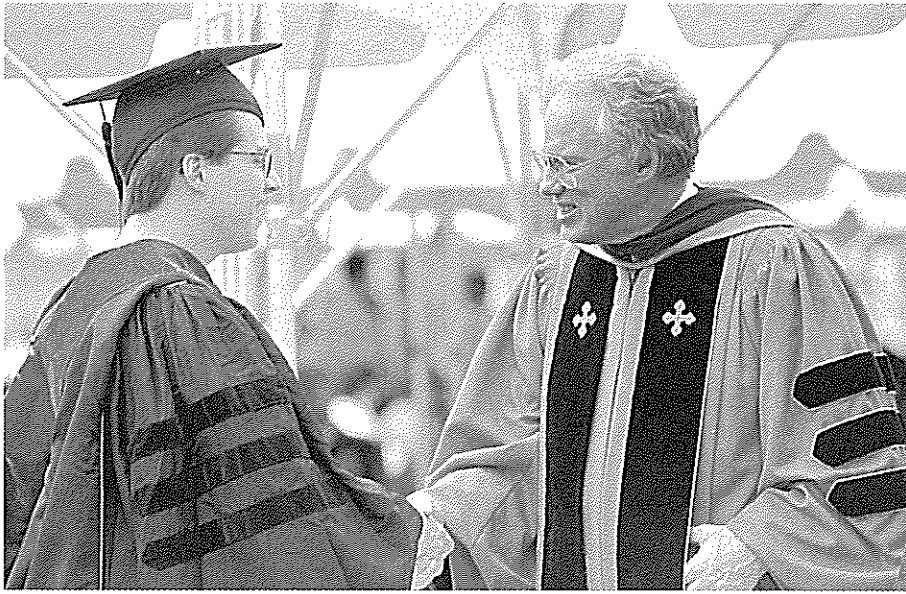
Her service to the College of Education is far-reaching. She has served as chair of the College of Education Campaign Steering Committee since 1995, as a member of the college's Alumni Advisory Board, and has participated in focus groups about the college's external image. In 1997, she established the Isabel Miller Scholarship in Early Childhood Education. She is a recipient of the college's "Friend of the College Award" in recognition of her long-standing commitment.

The entire campus community has benefited from Professor Miller's leadership. She was the first woman

president of The Faculty Club and has served on a number of committees of The Ohio State University Retirees Association (OSURA). She chaired two successful OSURA United Way campaigns in 1994 and 1995, and the association received two awards from United Way as a result of her fundraising expertise and commitment. In 1998, she was elected the first woman president of OSURA. She is a past president of the Ohio Elementary Kindergarten-Nursery Educators and has served on the university's Select Committee on Women and Minorities.

Ohio State gratefully recognizes the many years of service and commitment given by this dedicated alumna and friend.

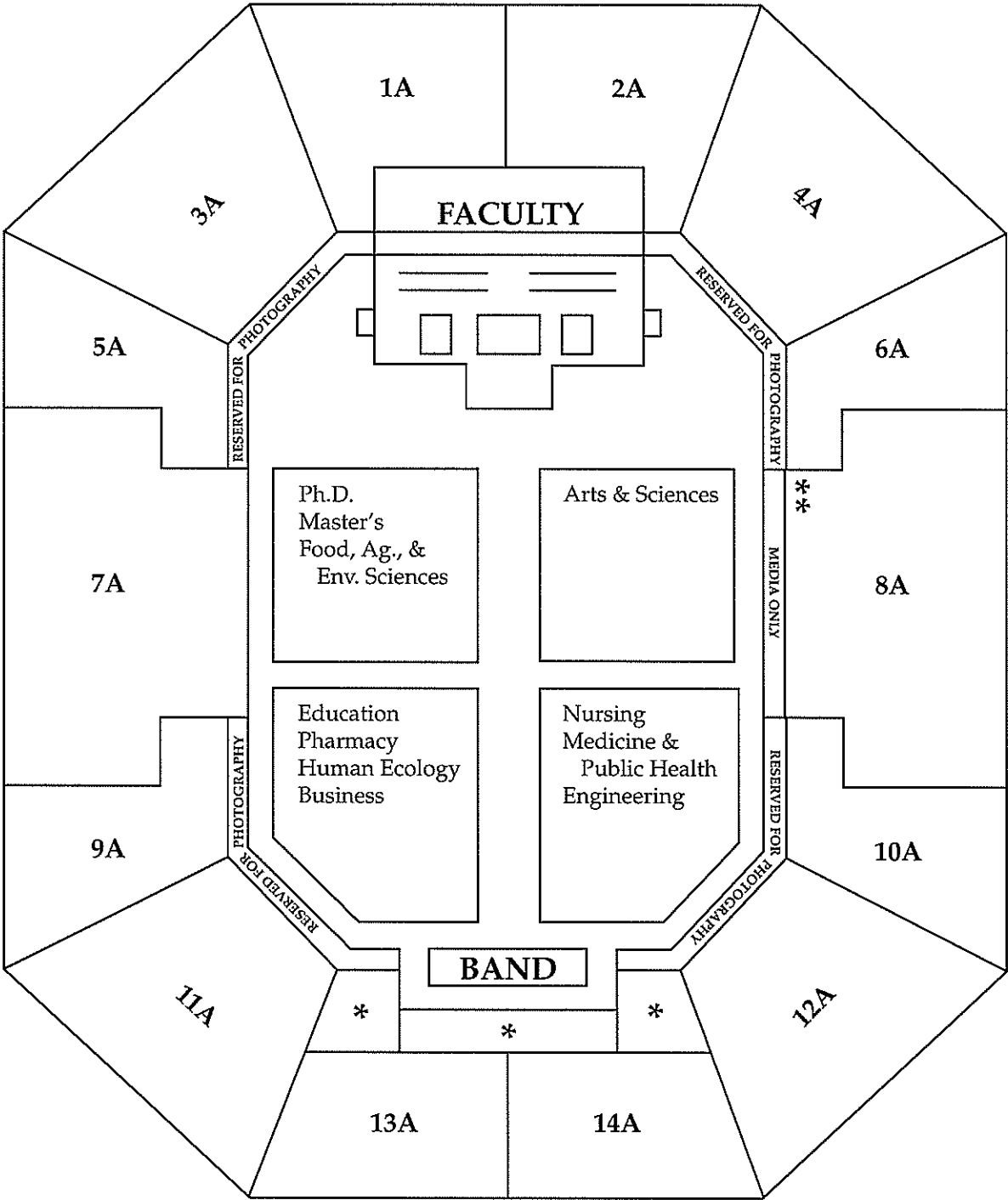

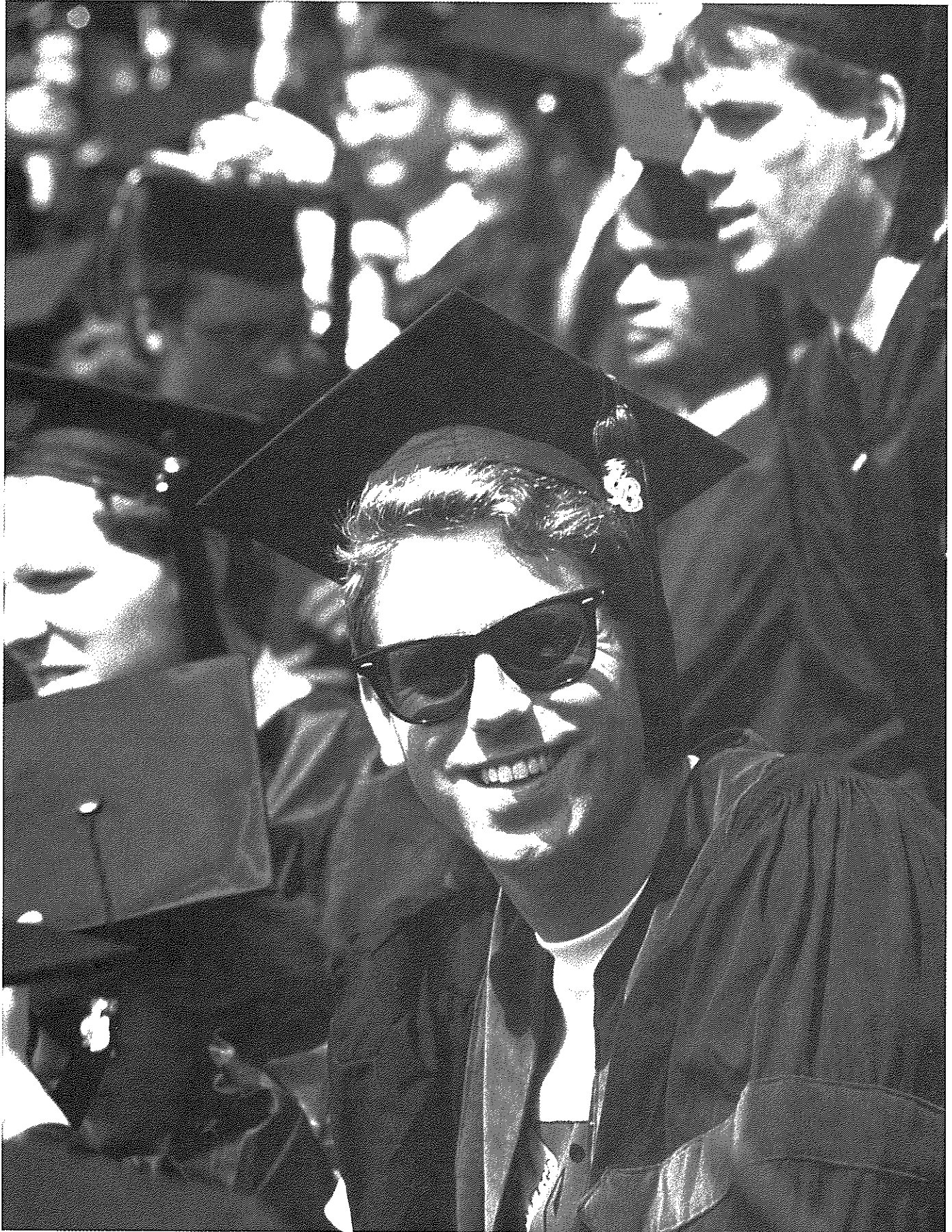

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard

square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: Black, long or short sleeves with a reshaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, with honors in the liberal arts, and with honors in pharmacy.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:

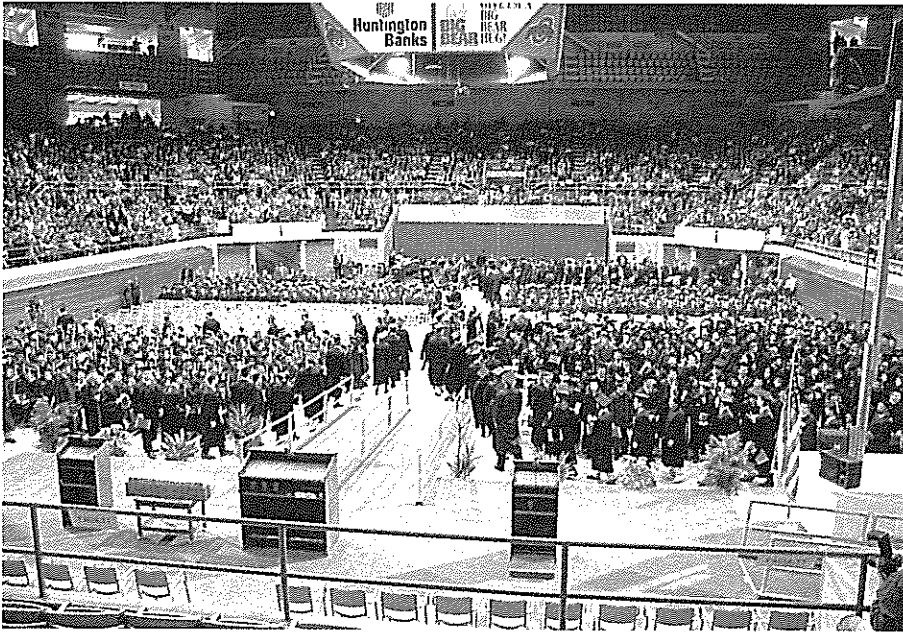

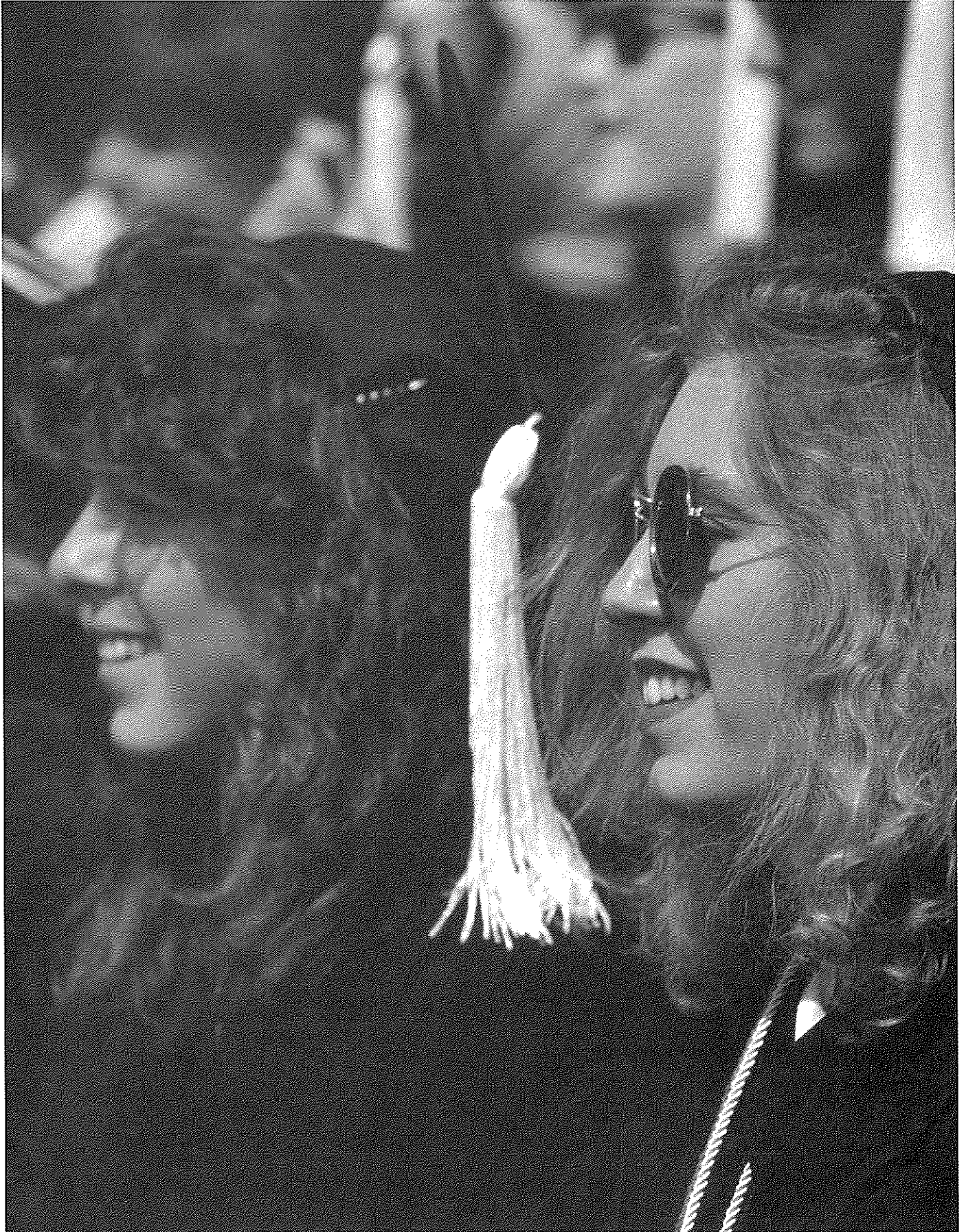
