Winter Fees and Refund Dates

Oct 16	Mon	First Day WI fees may be paid.
Jan 3	Wed	First day of WI classes. Last day to pay WI fees without a penalty. Last day to pay WI Residence Fees without penalty (RDH). First WI TOPP payment due.
Jan 4	Thur	WI Late Payment Penalty of \$100 starts. WI Late Registration Penalty of \$100 starts.
Jan 5	Fri	Last Day 100% Refund Period WI.
Jan 12	Fri	Last Day 80% Refund Period WI.
Jan 13	Sat	WI Late Payment Penalty increases to \$300. WI Late Registration Penalty increases to \$500.
Jan 19	Fri	Last Day 70% Refund Period WI.
Jan 26	Fri	Last Day 60% Refund Period WI.
Jan 28	Sun	Second WI TOPP payment due.
Feb 2	Fri	Last Day 50% Refund Period WI.
Feb 10	Sat	60% point in time for WI SFA withdrawal.

Note - All Students: Late fee payment penalty: \$100 for the second day of classes through the second Friday. Beginning on the second Saturday, the penalty increases to \$300.
